In November 2016, San Francisco voters approved Proposition A whose goal is to provide funding for much-needed school building improvements and to build two brand new schools in areas where the child population is growing rapidly. One of the two schools may be built in Mission Bay and now is the time to take the next steps to make this happen. **We need your help!**

School Board Commissioner Matt Haney and Commissioner Hydra Mendoza-McDonnell have drafted a resolution which will advance and shape the construction of the Mission Bay School. This resolution will be heard before the Budget Committee at the San Francisco Unified School District on **Wednesday, April 5th at 6PM** and If passed, then again before the full School Board on **Tuesday, April 25th, also at 6PM**
